Vicon Polygon product description

Polygon offers unique intuitive and time-saving tools for reporting and presentation, to enable you to communicate and share data.

Polygon 4.3.1 is a point release that includes new features for enhanced usability. For details see New features of Vicon Polygon on page 6.



Requirements for Vicon Polygon

Vicon recommends the Windows 7 (64-bit) operating system for use with Polygon 4.3.1. Polygon has also undergone limited testing under the Windows 10 (64-bit) operating system. Although Polygon may install and function under other Microsoft Windows operating systems, this is not officially supported or recommended by Vicon.

Polygon is fully integrated with Vicon Nexus and Vicon BodyBuilder through Eclipse data management.



License server requirements

If your organization licenses its Vicon product(s) from a server, ensure that the server meets the following criteria:

- It is unlikely to be powered down.
- It has a static IP address, so that client machines can find it easily and reliably.
- It is unlikely to have its hardware configuration changed, especially the HDD and NICs.



If your organization already uses a server, it is likely to fulfill the above criteria.




New features of Vicon Polygon


Video title display



When you create a movie pane, the video name is automatically displayed as the title at the top of the pane. This is particularly useful if you are displaying multiple video files, making it easy to identify each file.



Time Bar displays active data folder



Previously, events were displayed in the Time Bar, but it was not always obvious which trial they belonged to. To make it clear which events are currently displayed, the title of the active trial (the trial currently selected in the Data Bar), is now always displayed above the Time Bar.



Other updates

- To avoid scrolling when you load a large number of trials, the panes within the Data Bar are now resizable.
- When you choose a custom Graph Trace Color from the Attributes panel, the Context Appearance is automatically disabled, so that the relevant trace color in the graph is updated.
- Memory allocation has been improved to remove the limit on the number of videos you can load.



Vicon Polygon addressed issues

This section lists issues that have been addressed in the current release of Polygon.

Issue	Description
POLY-991	Export of Protected Report (ie with Protect Exported Report selected), followed by Open Report now correctly opens the exported report.
POLY-1034	A warning message no longer appears when closing VAULT after declining to use a trial license.
POLY-1046	Searching in ProEclipse inside Polygon now correctly handles the use of a space in the search terms.
POLY-1054	Multiple pop-up error messages no longer appear on saving/closing Polygon files.



Vicon Polygon known issues

This section lists known issues in the current release of Polygon.

Issue	Solution/Workaround
Under Windows 7, if you set the text size to 125% or 150%, Polygon's version number is cropped from the About Polygon dialog box. (POLY-731).	To display the version number, change the text size. This setting can be found in Windows Control Panel > Appearance and Personalization > Display.
